## Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

The following non-regular classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches

Winners of the following classes are eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition if undefeated in any other class at this show.

### Veteran (7 yrs & over)

Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches are eligible to enter Veteran classes

**Gun Dog Class** - For Dogs and Bitches that have an AKC Hunting title and/or an IWSCA Working Certificate and/or Working Certificate Excellent and/or an AKC Field Trial Title.

## Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**Stud Dog Class** – For Stud Dogs and at least two, and not more than six of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog class. The Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition.

*The Stud Dog* shall be considered one entry and requires one entry fee – this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee, if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the dog show rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed.

**Brood Bitch Class** - same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Stud Dogs and Brood Bitches may be spayed or neutered.

**Brace** – (For two dogs of the same breed and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers.) The dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at the time of entry. If a dog, which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only" fee of \$25 per dog. In making entries for "Brace Class Only"; full particulars must be given for each dog on individual, regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class". If more than one brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising **EACH** Brace must be so designated, "Brace No 1"; "Brace No 2"; etc. Entry fee is \$20.00 for unit. A separate entry form must be submitted for each dog.

**Generations Class** - The entries in the Non-Regular Class represent 3 generations of an Irish Water Spaniel pedigree in each "Entry". They are to be exhibited from the oldest to the youngest. In the Generations Class, each entry is judged on the merits of all 3 of the dogs (Example: dog, sire, grandsire). Entries in this class need not all be of the same sex. Spayed/neutered dogs may be exhibited in this class. At least one dog, from each entry in this class must be entered in a regular conformation class. In this Generations Class, each entry is evaluated on the merits of all the dogs presented and the overall consistency on maintaining the standard of the breed through the multiple generations.

*A separate entry form must be submitted for each dog.*

*Each Dog comprising each Generations entry **MUST** be designated at time of entry.*

## Awards of Merit

The Irish Water Spaniel Club of America offers Awards of Merit at its National Specialty Show in recognition of the quality dogs that are in serious contention for the top breed awards. It excludes the Best of Breed winner and the Best of Opposite Sex winner that by virtue of their placements have already been recognized. It is entirely the judge's decision whether to give all of the Awards of Merit, only some, or none. The number of awards that may be made is determined by the size of the entry based on the # of dogs competing in the Best of Breed ring including entered Champions of record, any move-ups, Veteran Dogs, Veteran Bitches, Winners Dog and Winners Bitch x 10% rounded up, with no consideration as to sex. AOMs should not be confused with Select Dog and Select Bitch which are AKC awards toward Grand Championship status and are to be awarded per AKC rules.

## Parades

These are non competitive classes. An entry form must be completed and submitted for each dog participating in any of the Parades. Entry fee for the Parades is \$15 regardless of whether the dog is entered in any regular conformation, obedience or agility classes.

**AKC All-Around IWS:** The parade of AKC All-Around IWS will serve to honor the Irish Water Spaniels who have earned the distinction of being awarded the AKC All-Around title for their completion of an AKC Championship (CH), AKC Obedience (CD, CDX, or UD) and AKC Hunt (JH, SH, or MH) titles.

**Title Holders:** The Parade of Title Holders will serve to honor all Irish Water Spaniels who have been awarded any AKC or IWSCA title(s). Any previous IWSCA Specialty winners will be so noted.

**Veterans:** The Parade of Veterans will serve to honor all Irish Water Spaniels 7 years old and over.

**Pets:** The Parade of Pets will serve to honor all Irish Water Spaniels who are beloved pets and companions, including those placed through the IWSCA Rescue program.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

**Novice Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Master Class** - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed.

**NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.** You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

## Sweepstakes

### Requirements & Classification

Sweepstakes is open to all Irish Water Spaniels who are at least six (6) months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Specialty Class at the regular entry fee. Entries shall be made at the same time, on the same entry form as for Regular Classes. Indicate your "Sweepstakes" Class and age division in the space for "Additional Classes".

### Sweepstakes Classifications

Puppy, 6 Mos & Under 9 Mos • Puppy, 9 Mos & Under 12 Mos  
12 Mos & Under 15 Mos • 15 Mos & Under 18 Mos

### Division of Entry Money as Prizes for Sweepstakes & Veteran Sweepstakes

Thirty-five (35%) percent of the total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remaining 65% will be divided as follows:

20% between Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite to Best in Sweepstakes

**Best in Sweepstakes: 60%**      **Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes: 40%**

Remainder to be divided as follows:

First Place in Each Class .....	40% of Entry Fee for Class
Second Place in Each Class .....	30% of Entry Fee for Class
Third Place in Each Class .....	20% of Entry Fee for Class
Fourth Place in Each Class .....	10% of Entry Fee for Class

All money not claimed as prizes due to absence shall revert back to the club.

### Veteran Sweepstakes Requirements & Classification

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Irish Water Spaniels who are at least seven (7) years of age on the day of the show. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in the regular Specialty classes or at the regular entry fee. Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided. Entrants need not hold a Champion of Record title to compete.

# AKC Sanctioned Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Competition

## Friday, April 19, 2013

**Entry Fee:** \$20.00 per puppy

One combined class will be offered for Irish Water Spaniels that are (4) four months & under (6) six months. **There will be a selection of Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy**

An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for entries in this competition.

A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.

Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.*

AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

Exhibitors should open the mouth of their puppy for examination.

Male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused but the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points must be withheld.

Dogs with breed standard disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements. However, dogs with age related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-to-6 Month Puppy classes.

Dogs must be excused for attacking a person or other dogs.
